Latest position on Millbrook Surgery

We are pleased to say that agreement has been reached to secure the future of Millbrook Surgery.

The owner has agreed to sell the building to a property company that specialises in providing GP premises. Under current policy this is the only means of securing the surgery for the use of NHS services in the long term.

The arrangement means Millbrook will be leased back so Rame Group Practice can continue to provide care. The cost to the NHS is in line with the expectations of the district valuer, who helps safeguard taxpayer interests.

If the sale cannot be finalised by 1 April, then the current licence will be extended to make sure the doors stay open for patients.

Dr Lawrence Barnes, partner at Rame Group Practice, said: “We’re really pleased that a deal’s been struck on the surgery, because that means we can carry on providing care without any disruption. That makes life simpler for everyone.”
